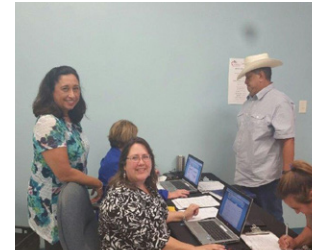


### 3rd Annual "Back To School" Teachers Fair (Solomon P. Ortiz International Center)
