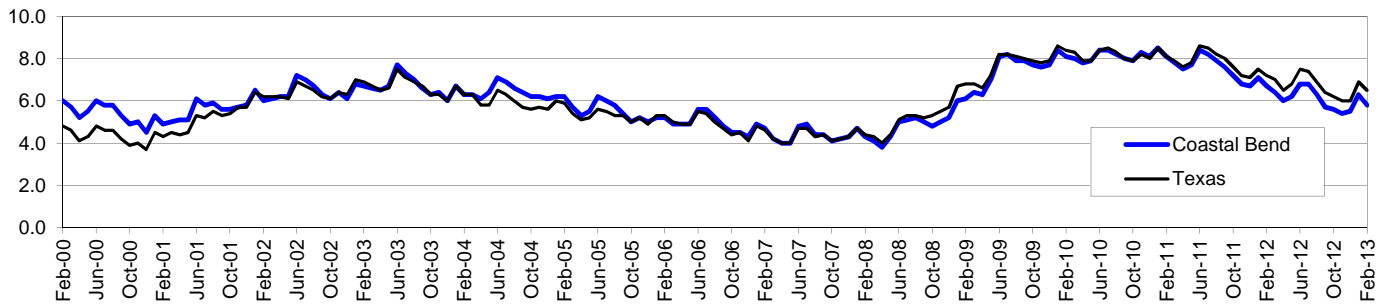

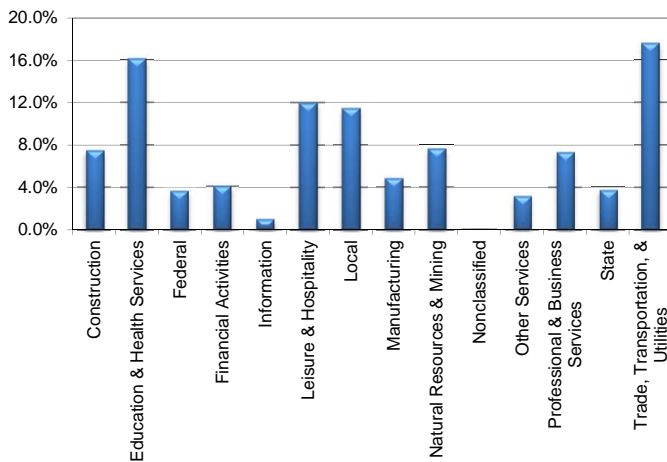

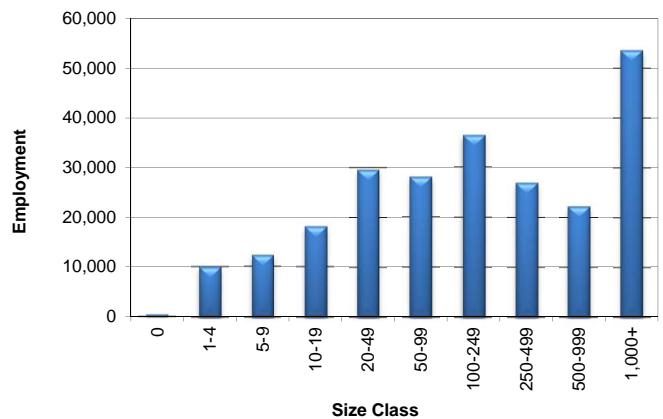

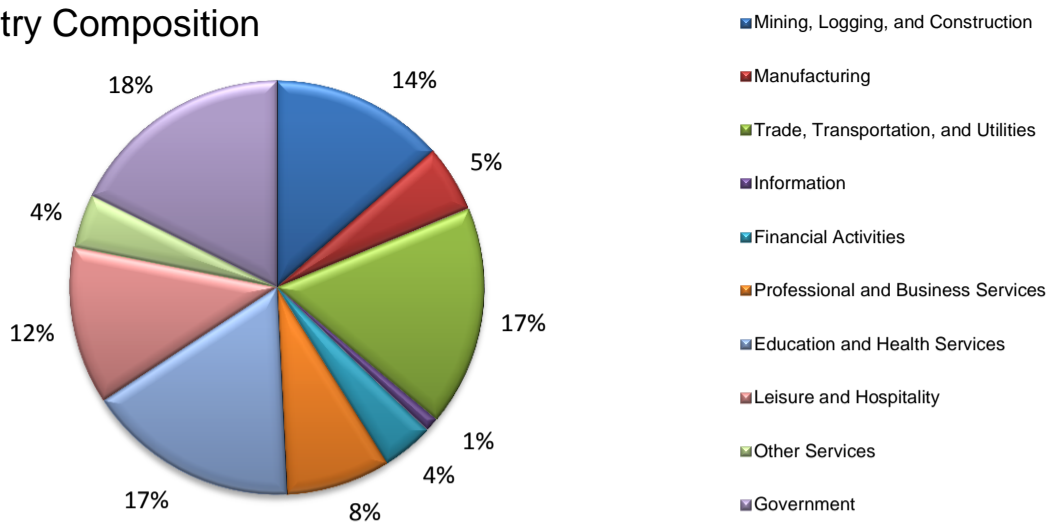
Size Class Employment Composition 3rd Quarter 2012



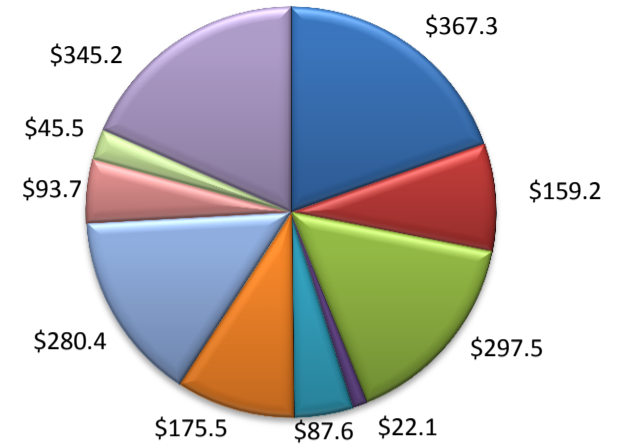

3rd Quarter 2012



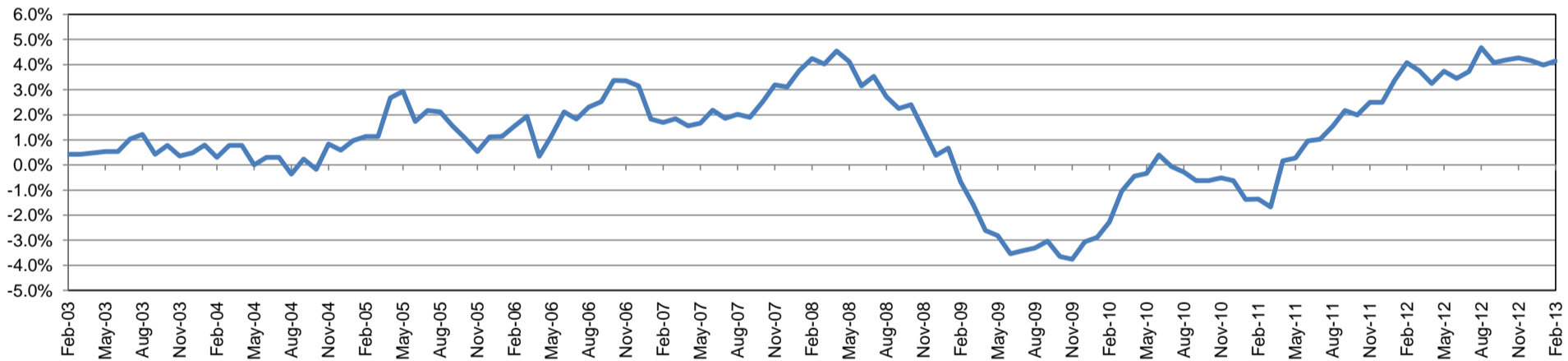
