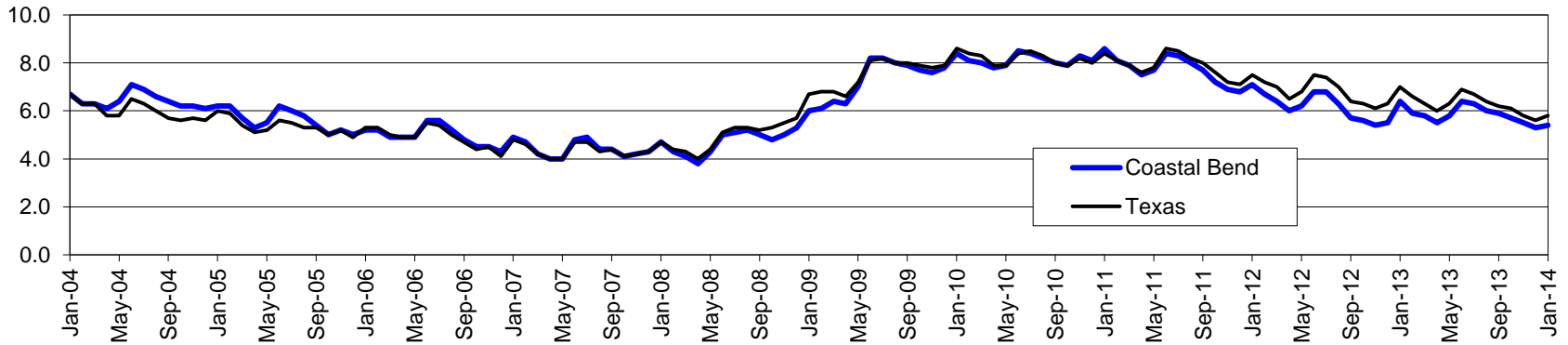

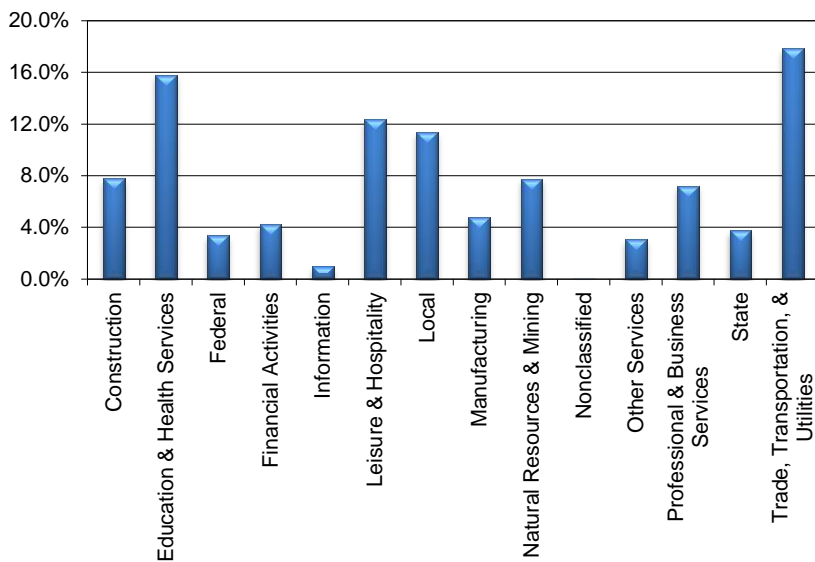

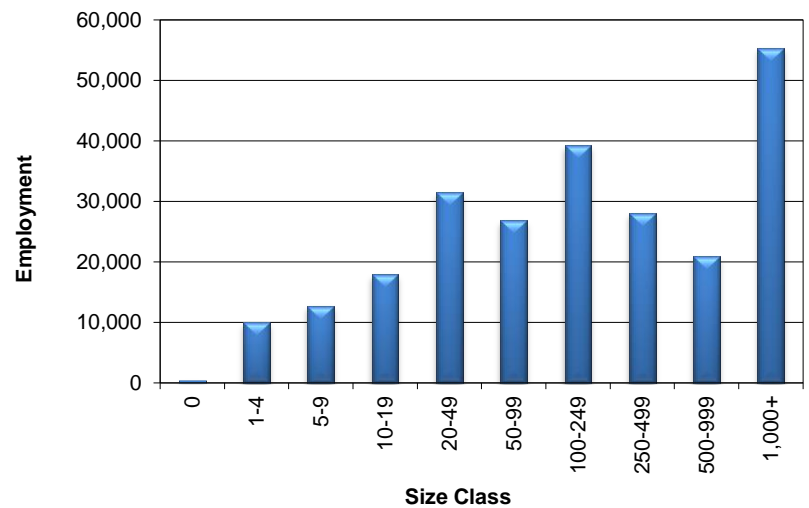

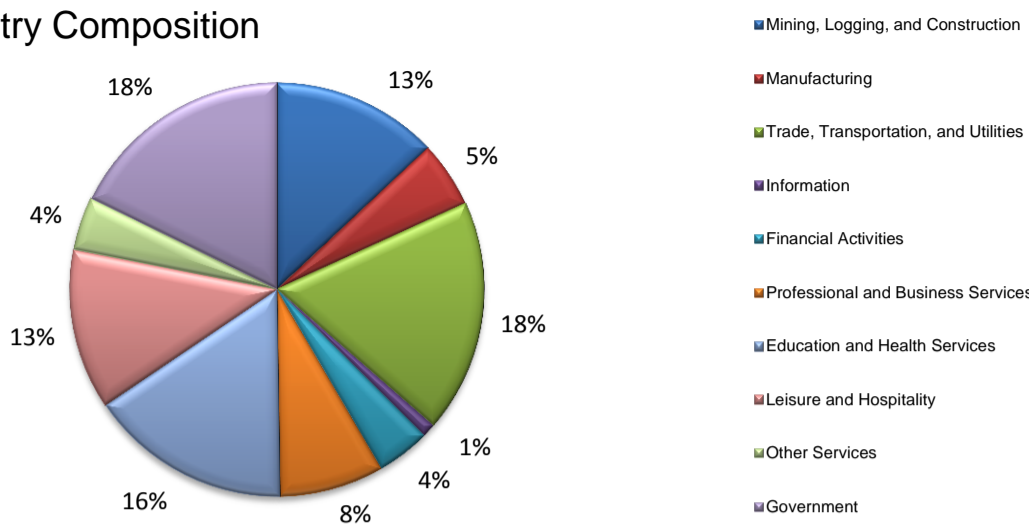
Size Class Employment Composition 3rd Quarter 2013



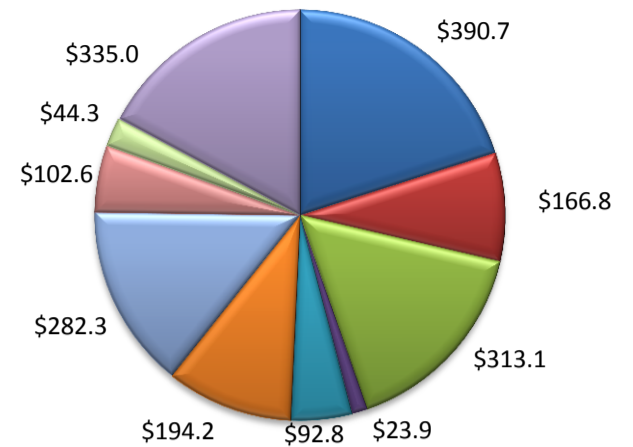

3rd Quarter 2013



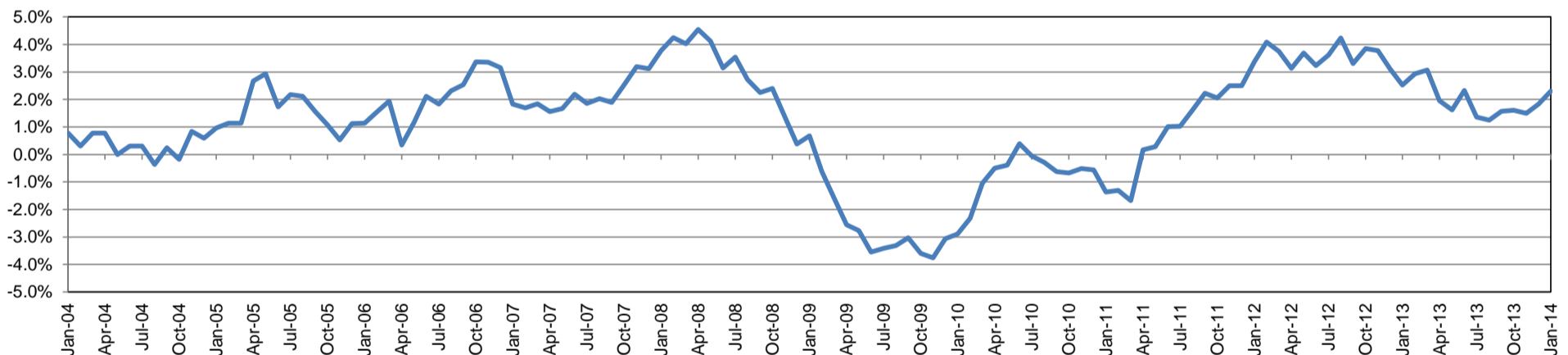
