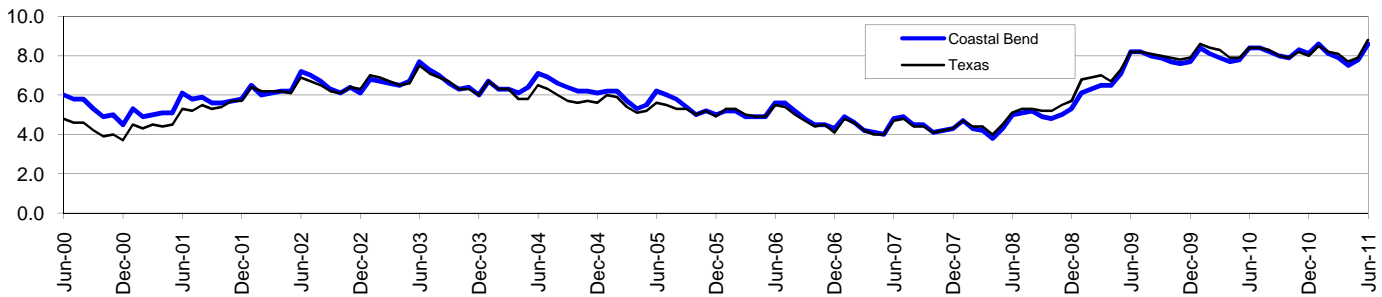

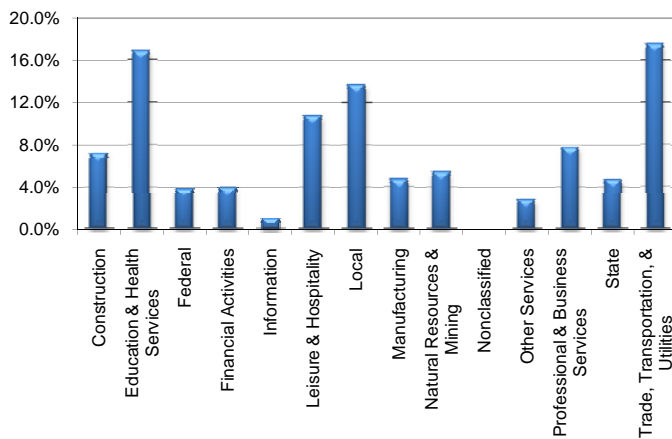

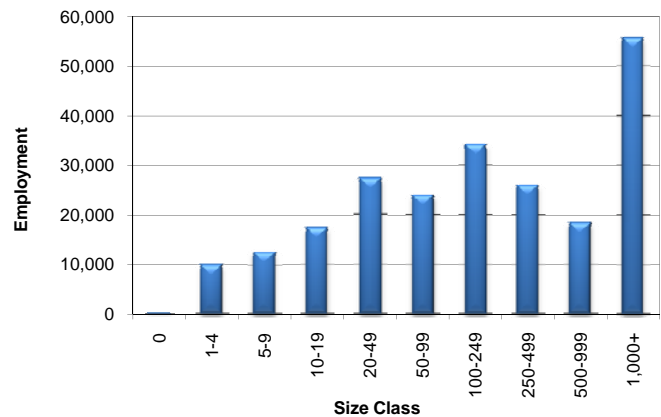

Size Class Employment Composition 4th Quarter 2010



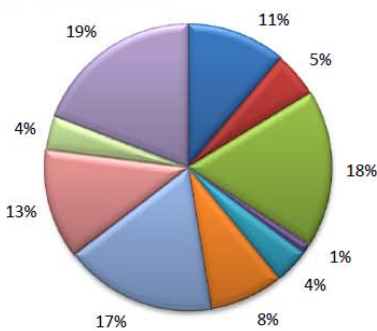

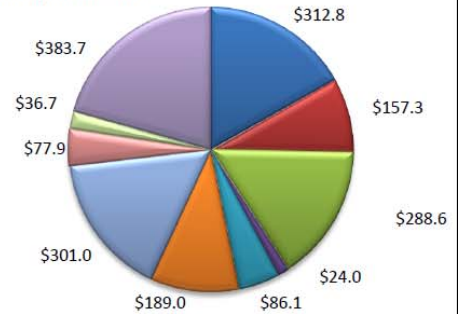

4th Quarter 2010



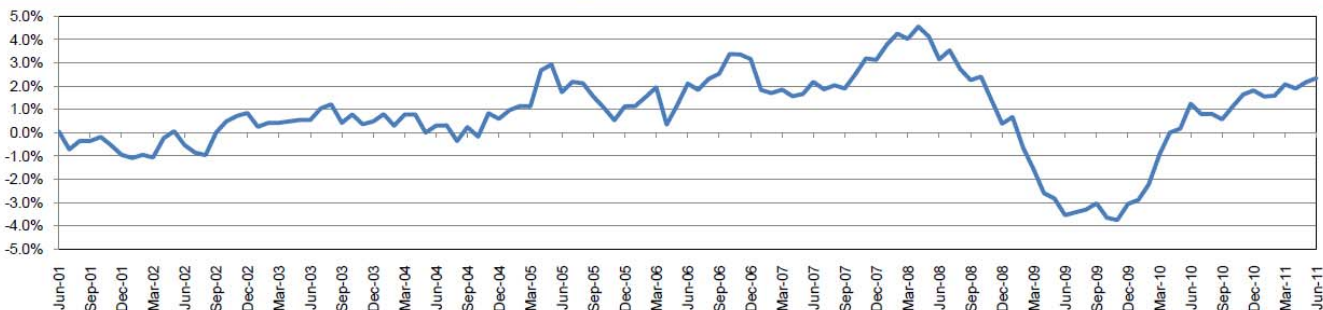
