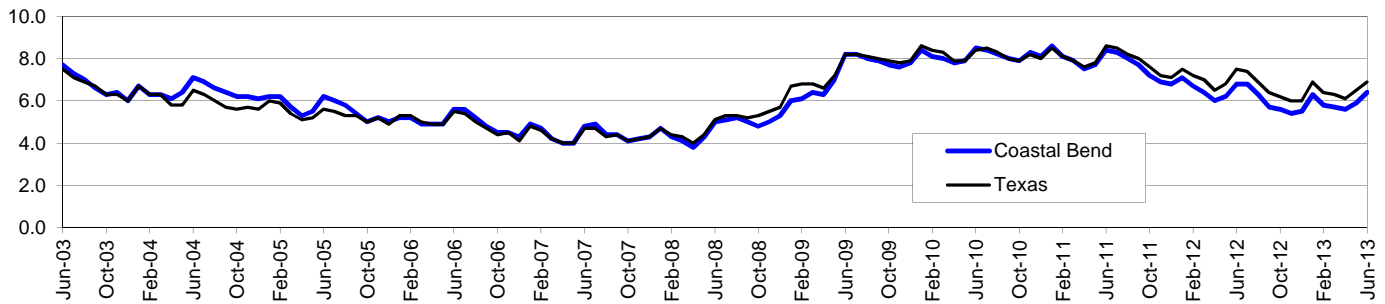

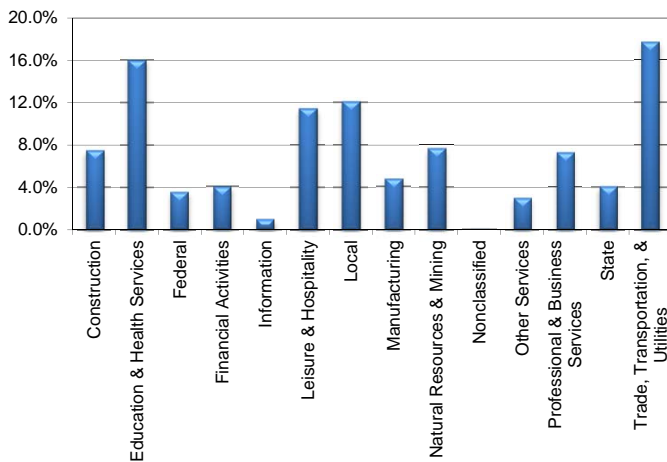

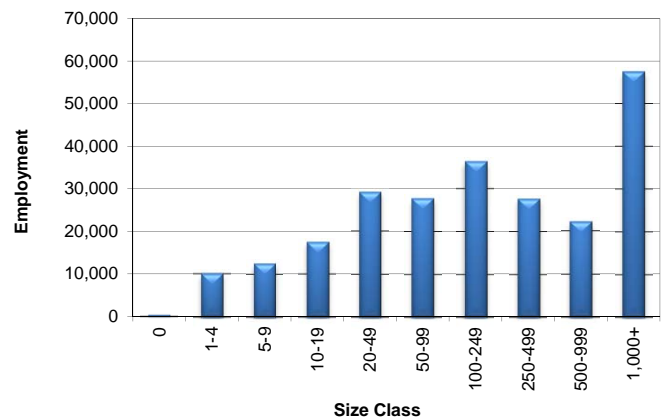

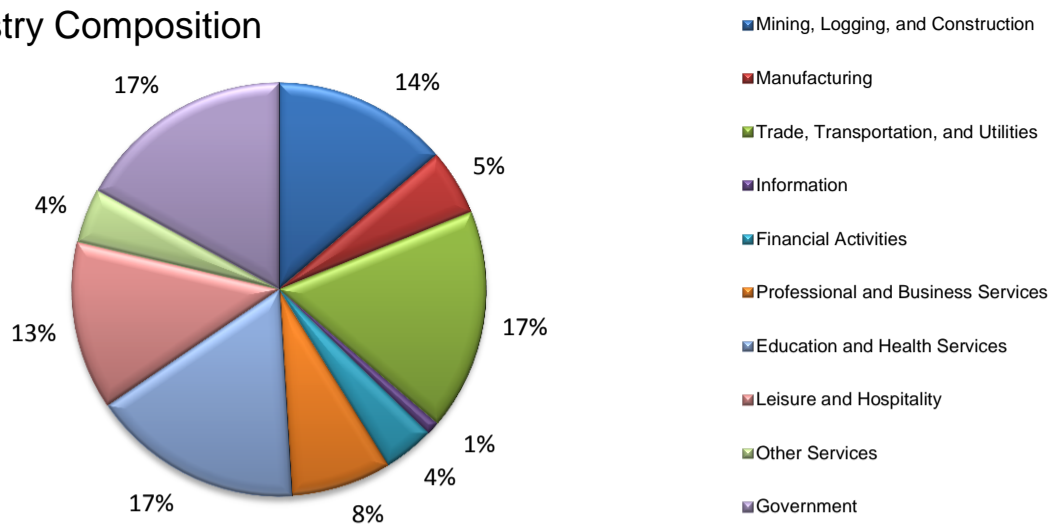
Size Class Employment Composition 4th Quarter 2012



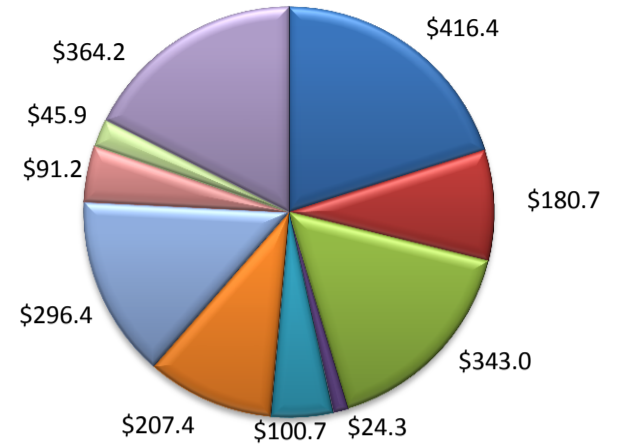

4th Quarter 2012



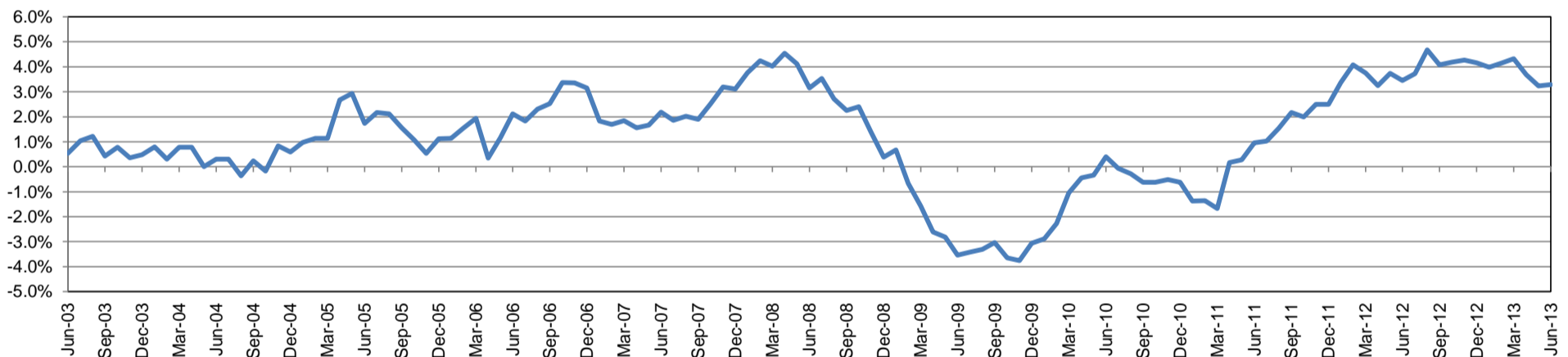
