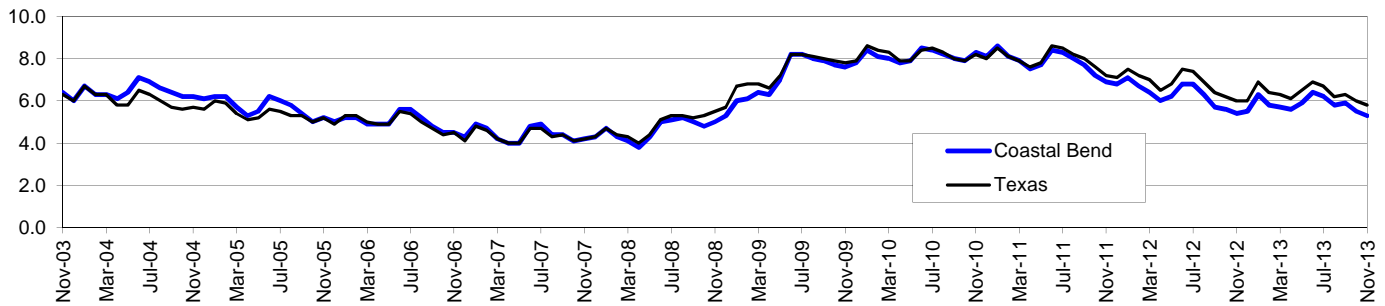

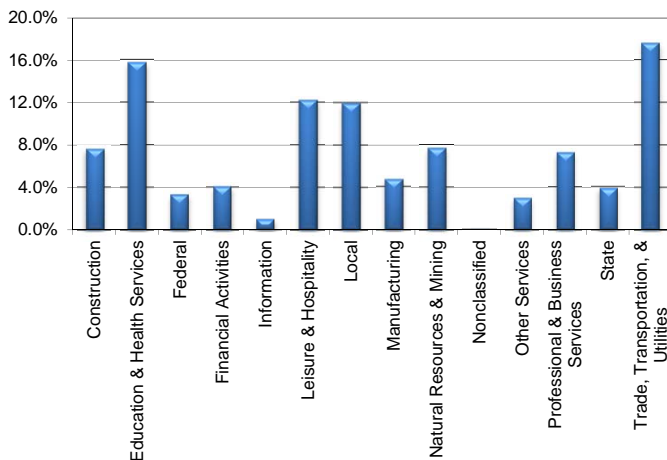

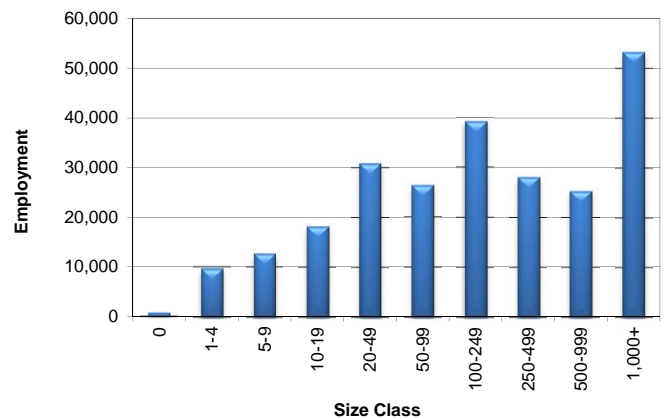

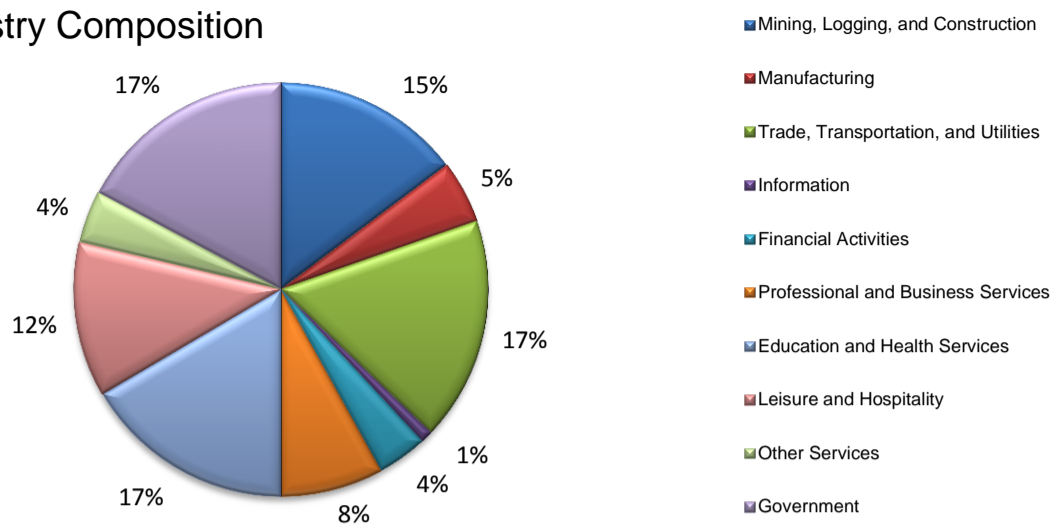
Size Class Employment Composition 2nd Quarter 2013



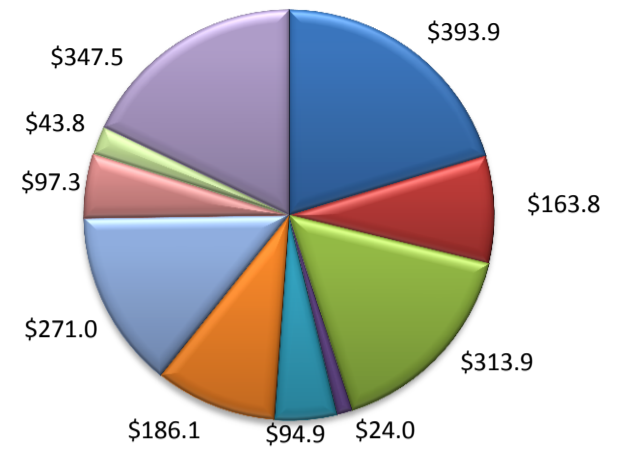

2nd Quarter 2013



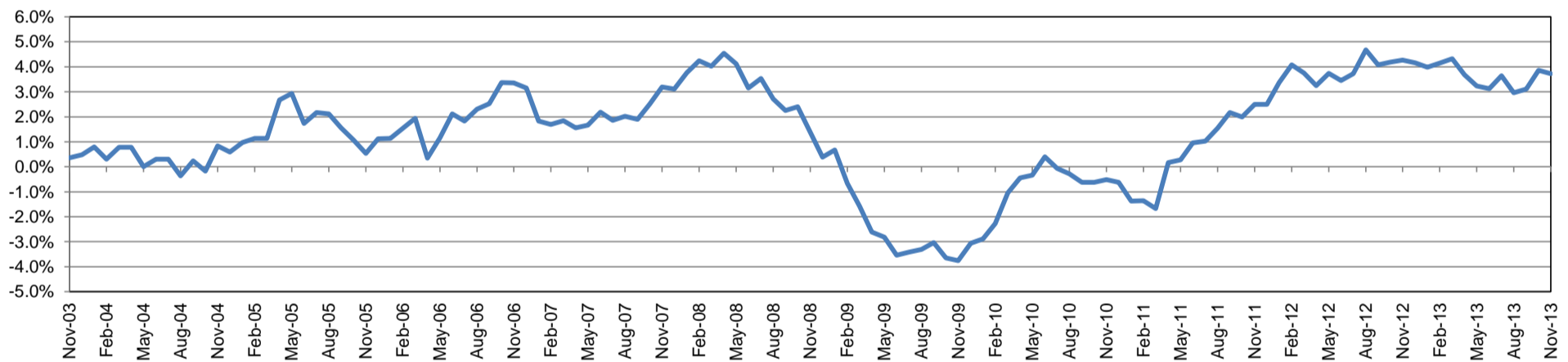
