

LEADERS DISCUSS HURRICANE HARVEY DISASTER UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) and Workforce Solutions of the Coastal Bend (WFSCB) have been helping and serving workers and self-employed individuals who have been unable to work due to Hurricane Harvey. TWC Commissioner Ruth Hughs was at the Staples Career Center on August 31st to announce the Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA) available for the Coastal Bend Region.

In addition, WFSCB has been deploying two **Disaster Relief Employment Assistance Mobile Units** throughout the Coastal Bend region delivering needed workforce services to cities and counties impacted by the disaster. They are a "Workforce Center" on wheels equipped with computers, wi-fi, printers, and copiers to help those file for unemployment and for other workforce services.
