WFSCB congratulates the 12 Child Care Providers who completed the training to better educate our future workforce by providing them with the skills to be "school ready" and "life ready".

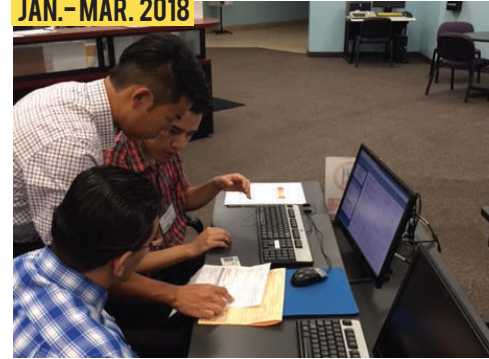

VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE (VITA) PROGRAM

For over nine years, WFSCB has been a Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Partner providing free tax preparation services to hundreds of taxpayers – including those of limited means, the elderly, people with disabilities and people with limited English proficiency. This is the fifth year that the Sunrise Career Center has been a VITA host site preparing taxes at no cost to residents and helping them claim Earned Income Tax Credits (EITC) and Child Tax Credit. The VITA program offers free tax help to people who generally make \$66,000 or less.
